What impact did the Home Rule Act of 1973 have on self-governance for Washington, D.C.?

The Home Rule Act of 1973 moved Washington, D.C. toward self-governance by giving the district the power to elect a mayor and elect a district council. The Home Rule Act also gave the newly formed District Council the ability to pass local laws. On the other hand, Washington, D.C. still faced restrictions. The new laws created still needed approval of Congress. Additionally, the District's budget needed approval of Congress.
